WHEN ASKED WHY THIS ANONYMOUS STUDENT WENT TO



MR. LASKOW, THE STUDENT RE-SPONDED THAT HE WANTED TO SPEAK WITH THE ART TEACHER BECAUSE HE WAS IN THE GREAT-EST POSITION TO MAKE A DIFFER-ENCE. "HE CAME TO ME AND ASKED IF ART CLUB WOULD BE ABLE TO CREATE A MURAL THAT ADDRESSED THE DANGER OF BUL-LYING: HE WAS CONVINCED THAT THE BEST WAY TO STOP IT WAS TO CREATE A VISUAL DEMONSTRA-TION OF ITS TERRIBLE CONSE-QUENCES."
